

NFWB PLAY-UP POLICY

It is the policy of NFWB to allow a player to play up one division above the division they are age appropriate for if all of the following criteria are met:

1. They have already played at least one season in the division they are trying to place out of;
2. They are age appropriate for the division they are trying to place out of;
3. They attend the evaluation (if applicable) for their age appropriate division;
4. They attend the evaluation of the division they are trying to play up into;
5. They rank in the upper percentile of those players that are evaluated for the league as defined below:

A Pinto league player wishing to play in the Mustang league must be ranked in the upper 30th percentile

A Mustang league player wishing to play in the Bronco league must be ranked in the upper 20th percentile

A Bronco league player wishing to play in the Pony league must be ranked in the upper 10th percentile

For a Softball player to play up a league, they must score in the upper 50th percentile

If all of the above are not met, the player will play in his/her age appropriate league to develop their skills. Parents of children who do not qualify for playing up and decide to remove their child from the league will forfeit their registration fee.
